

Exercise Key-Perfect Form of Tense

1) She will have published her book.

Neg: She will not have published her book.

Que: Will she have published her book?

2) She had written a poem for her mother.

Neg: She had not written a poem for her mother.

Que: Had she written a poem for her mother?

3) The team has won the championship.

Neg: The team has not won the championship.

Que: Has the team won the championship?

4) It will have been a fulfilling career.

Neg: It will not have been a fulfilling career.

Que: Will it have been a fulfilling career?

5) He has completed the task.

Neg: He has not completed the task.

Que: Has he completed the task?
