

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) Have they been playing basketball since noon?

Pos: They have been playing basketball since noon.

Neq: They have not been playing basketball since noon.

2) Had I been studying English for two hours?

Pos: I had been studying English for two hours.

Neg: I had not been studying English for two hours.

3) Had he been playing video games since morning?

Pos: He had been playing video games since morning.

Neg: He had not been playing video games since morning.

Will I have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive?

Pos: I will have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive.

Neg: I will not have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive.

Had Sarah been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance?

Pos: Sarah had been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

Neg: Sarah had not been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.
