

## Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: They have been playing basketball since noon.

Neg: They have not been playing basketball since noon.

Que: Have they been playing basketball since noon?

2) Pos: I had been studying English for two hours.

Neg: I had not been studying English for two hours.

Que: Had I been studying English for two hours?

3) Pos: He had been playing video games since morning.

Neg: He had not been playing video games since morning.

Que: Had he been playing video games since morning?

4) Pos: I will have been working on this project for three

hours by the time you arrive.

Neg: I will not have been working on this project for three

hours by the time you arrive.

Que: Will I have been working on this project for three hours

by the time you arrive?

5) Pos: Sarah had been practicing the piano for years before

her concert performance.

Neg: Sarah had not been practicing the piano for years before

her concert performance.

Que: Had Sarah been practicing the piano for years before her

concert performance?
