

Exercise Key-Perfect Form of Tense

1) They have seen that movie.

Neg: They have not seen that movie.

Que: Have they seen that movie?

2) She will have found a new job.

Neg: She will not have found a new job.

Que: Will she have found a new job?

3) They will have booked their tickets.

Neg: They will not have booked their tickets.

Que: Will they have booked their tickets?

4) It will have been a successful venture.

Neg: It will not have been a successful venture.

Que: Will it have been a successful venture?

5) We will have celebrated the anniversary.

Neg: We will not have celebrated the anniversary.

Que: Will we have celebrated the anniversary?
