

Exercise Key-Perfect Continuous Form of Tense

1) Had he been playing video games since morning?

Pos: He had been playing video games since morning.

Neg: He had not been playing video games since morning.

2) Has she been gardening for hours?

Pos: She has been gardening for hours.

Neg: She has not been gardening for hours.

3) Had I been working on the project all day long?

Pos: I had been working on the project all day long.

Neg: I had not been working on the project all day long.

4) Has he been playing video games all day?

Pos: He has been playing video games all day.

Neg: He has not been playing video games all day.

5) Has it been snowing continuously since yesterday?

Pos: It has been snowing continuously since yesterday.

Neg: It has not been snowing continuously since yesterday.
