

Exercise Key-Perfect Continuous Form of Tense

1) He had not been playing video games since morning.

Pos: He had been playing video games since morning.

Que: Had he been playing video games since morning?

2) She has not been gardening for hours.

Pos: She has been gardening for hours.

Que: Has she been gardening for hours?

3) I had not been working on the project all day long.

Pos: I had been working on the project all day long.

Que: Had I been working on the project all day long?

4) He has not been playing video games all day.

Pos: He has been playing video games all day.

Que: Has he been playing video games all day?

5) It has not been snowing continuously since yesterday.

Pos: It has been snowing continuously since yesterday.

Que: Has it been snowing continuously since yesterday?
