Neg: They are not having a party tonight.

Que: Are they having a party tonight?

2) They play basketball after school.

Neg: They don't play basketball after school.

Que: Do they play basketball after school?

3) The children have been playing outside all afternoon.

Neg: The children have not been playing outside all afternoon.

Que: Have the children been playing outside all afternoon?

4) It is snowing outside.

Neg: It is not snowing outside.

Que: Is it snowing outside?

5) I enjoy eating pizza.

Neg: I don't enjoy eating pizza.

Que: Do I enjoy eating pizza?
