Neg: The children have not been playing outside all afternoon.

4) Is it snowing outside?

Pos: It is snowing outside.

Neg: It is not snowing outside.

5) Do I enjoy eating pizza?

Pos: I enjoy eating pizza.

Neg: I don't enjoy eating pizza.
