1) Sarah had not been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Pos: Sarah had been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Que: Had Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

2) They had not been working on the project for weeks.

Pos: They had been working on the project for weeks.

Que: Had they been working on the project for weeks?

3) The students have not been studying for exams.

Pos: The students have been studying for exams.

Que: Have the students been studying for exams?

4) He has not been practicing his speech.

Pos: He has been practicing his speech.

Que: Has he been practicing his speech?

John had not been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it.

Pos: John had been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it.

Que: Had John been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it?

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
