

## Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: Sarah had been cooking dinner for the family for

hours.

Neg: Sarah had not been cooking dinner for the family for

hours.

Que: Had Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

2) Pos: They had been working on the project for weeks.

Neg: They had not been working on the project for weeks.

Que: Had they been working on the project for weeks?

3) Pos: The students have been studying for exams.

Neg: The students have not been studying for exams.

Que: Have the students been studying for exams?

4) Pos: He has been practicing his speech.

**Neg:** He has not been practicing his speech.

Que: Has he been practicing his speech?

5) Pos: John had been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it.

Neg: John had not been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it

he finally completed it.

Que: Had John been working on his novel for months before he

finally completed it?
