

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) Have the children been playing in the park all afternoon?

Pos: The children have been playing in the park all afternoon.

Neg: The children have not been playing in the park all afternoon.

2) Had it been snowing since early morning?

Pos: It had been snowing since early morning.

Neg: It had not been snowing since early morning.

3) Have they been discussing the issue for hours?

Pos: They have been discussing the issue for hours.

Neg: They have not been discussing the issue for hours.

4) Had Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

Pos: Sarah had been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Neg: Sarah had not been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

5) Have they been talking on the phone for hours?

Pos: They have been talking on the phone for hours.

Neg: They have not been talking on the phone for hours.
