Pos: The children have been playing in the park all afternoon.

Que: Have the children been playing in the park all afternoon?

2) It had not been snowing since early morning.

Pos: It had been snowing since early morning.

Que: Had it been snowing since early morning?

3) They have not been discussing the issue for hours.

Pos: They have been discussing the issue for hours.

Que: Have they been discussing the issue for hours?

4) Sarah had not been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Pos: Sarah had been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Que: Had Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

5) They have not been talking on the phone for hours.

Pos: They have been talking on the phone for hours.

Que: Have they been talking on the phone for hours?
