

## Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: The children have been playing in the park all

afternoon.

Neg: The children have not been playing in the park all

afternoon.

Que: Have the children been playing in the park all afternoon?

2) Pos: It had been snowing since early morning.

Neg: It had not been snowing since early morning.

Que: Had it been snowing since early morning?

3) Pos: They have been discussing the issue for hours.

Neg: They have not been discussing the issue for hours.

Que: Have they been discussing the issue for hours?

4) Pos: Sarah had been cooking dinner for the family for

hours.

Neg: Sarah had not been cooking dinner for the family for

hours.

Que: Had Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

5) Pos: They have been talking on the phone for hours.

Neg: They have not been talking on the phone for hours.

Que: Have they been talking on the phone for hours?
