1) We played board games all night.

Neg: We didn't play board games all night.

Que: Did you play board games all night?

2) My friend won a prize in the competition last month.

Neg: My friend didn't win a prize in the competition last month.

Que: Did your friend win a prize in the competition last month?

3) I traveled to a different city for a family gathering.

Neg: I didn't travel to a different city for a family gathering.

Que: Did you travel to a different city for a family gathering?

4) She will visit her grandparents this weekend.

Neg: She will not visit her grandparents this weekend.

Que: Will she visit her grandparents this weekend?

5) He scored a touchdown during the football game.

Neg: He didn't score a touchdown during the football game.

Que: Did he score a touchdown during the football game?
