1) He has not been working on his novel since last year.

Pos: He has been working on his novel since last year.

Que: Has he been working on his novel since last year?

The workers had not been building the house for months before it was completed.

Pos: The workers had been building the house for months before it was completed.

Que: Had the workers been building the house for months before it was completed?

3) It had not been raining heavily all afternoon.

Pos: It had been raining heavily all afternoon.

Que: Had it been raining heavily all afternoon?

4) She had not been cooking dinner for the family all evening.

Pos: She had been cooking dinner for the family all evening.

Que: Had she been cooking dinner for the family all evening?

5) She had not been painting since morning.

Pos: She had been painting since morning.

Que: Had she been painting since morning?
