

Exercise Key-Perfect Form of Tense

1) I have learned a new language.

Neg: I have not learned a new language.

Que: Have I learned a new language?

2) She had traveled to Europe last summer.

Neg: She had not traveled to Europe last summer.

Que: Had she traveled to Europe last summer?

3) He will have received the award.

Neg: He will not have received the award.

Que: Will he have received the award?

4) He had visited Paris twice before.

Neg: He had not visited Paris twice before.

Que: Had he visited Paris twice before?

5) It had been a busy day at work.

Neg: It had not been a busy day at work.

Que: Had it been a busy day at work?
