

Exercise Key-Perfect Form of Tense

1) Have I learned a new language?

Pos: I have learned a new language.

Neg: I have not learned a new language.

2) Had she traveled to Europe last summer?

Pos: She had traveled to Europe last summer.

Neg: She had not traveled to Europe last summer.

3) Will he have received the award?

Pos: He will have received the award.

Neg: He will not have received the award.

4) Had he visited Paris twice before?

Pos: He had visited Paris twice before.

Neg: He had not visited Paris twice before.

5) Had it been a busy day at work?

Pos: It had been a busy day at work.

Neg: It had not been a busy day at work.
