1) Do you enjoy playing video games?

Neg: I don't enjoy playing video games.

2) Has she been gardening for hours?

Neg: She has not been gardening for hours.

3) Is the car parked?

Neg: The car is not parked.

4) Have you been working on the project all day?

Neg: You have not been working on the project all day.

5) Have the students been studying for exams?

Neg: The students have not been studying for exams.

6) Do they eat pizza for lunch?

Neg: They don't eat pizza for lunch.

7) Are they playing video games?

Neg: They are not playing video games.

8) Have we been traveling for weeks?

Neg: We have not been traveling for weeks.

9) Have I been practicing yoga for the past month?

Neg: I have not been practicing yoga for the past month.

10) Do I enjoy playing video games?

Neg: I don't enjoy playing video games.
