6) Sarah had not been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

Pos: Had Sarah been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance?

7) The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

Pos: Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining?

8) I had not been waiting for the bus since morning.

Pos: Had I been waiting for the bus since morning?

9) You had not been working on the project for hours.

Pos: Had you been working on the project for hours?

10) He had not been studying for the exam all night.

Pos: Had he been studying for the exam all night?
