2) Had he been studying Spanish for months?

Pos: He had been studying Spanish for months.

3) Had she been teaching at the school for ten years before she retired?

Pos: She had been teaching at the school for ten years before she retired.

4) Had the construction workers been building the house for several months before it was completed?

Pos: The construction workers had been building the house for several months before it was completed.

5) Had Sarah been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance?

Pos: Sarah had been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

6) Will Sarah have been working on her novel for months?

Pos: Sarah will have been working on her novel for months.

7) Had it been raining heavily all afternoon?

Pos: It had been raining heavily all afternoon.

8) Have we been waiting for our food for a long time?

Pos: We have been waiting for our food for a long time.

9) Had the company been developing new products for months before launching them in the market?

Pos: The company had been developing new products for months before launching them in the market.

10) Had she been practicing the piano for hours?

Pos: She had been practicing the piano for hours.
