

Exercise Key-Perfect Form of Tense

1) You had arrived before me.

Neg: You had not arrived before me.

Que: Had you arrived before me?

2) You will have completed the assignment.

Neg: You will not have completed the assignment.

Que: Will you have completed the assignment?

3) She will have traveled to Europe.

Neg: She will not have traveled to Europe.

Que: Will she have traveled to Europe?

4) I will have learned a new skill.

Neg: I will not have learned a new skill.

Que: Will I have learned a new skill?

5) We have cooked dinner.

Neg: We have not cooked dinner.

Que: Have we cooked dinner?
