

## Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: I have been practicing yoga for the past month.

Neg: I have not been practicing yoga for the past month.

Que: Have I been practicing yoga for the past month?

2) Pos: Sarah will have been working as a teacher for five years by the end of this month.

Neg: Sarah will not have been working as a teacher for five

years by the end of this month.

Que: Will Sarah have been working as a teacher for five years

by the end of this month?

3) Pos: The children have been playing outside for hours.

Neg: The children have not been playing outside for hours.

Que: Have the children been playing outside for hours?

4) Pos: I had been studying for the exam all night.

Neg: I had not been studying for the exam all night.

Que: Had I been studying for the exam all night?

5) Pos: They will have been rehearsing for the play for weeks when opening night arrives.

Neg: They will not have been rehearsing for the play for weeks when opening night arrives.

Will they have been rehearsing for the play for weeks

when opening night arrives?
