

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) Had you been studying for the exam all night?

Pos: You had been studying for the exam all night.

Neg: You had not been studying for the exam all night.

2) Will they have been rehearsing for the play for weeks?

Pos: They will have been rehearsing for the play for weeks.

Neg: They will not have been rehearsing for the play for weeks.

3) Has she been painting a picture all day?

Pos: She has been painting a picture all day.

Neg: She has not been painting a picture all day.

4) Had it been raining heavily since yesterday evening?

Pos: It had been raining heavily since yesterday evening.

Neg: It had not been raining heavily since yesterday evening.

5) Has he been playing football since this morning?

Pos: He has been playing football since this morning.

Neg: He has not been playing football since this morning.
