Neg: He will not have bought a new house.

2) Will she have started her own business?

Neg: She will not have started her own business.

3) Will we have planted the garden?

Neg: We will not have planted the garden.

4) Will they have traveled the world?

Neg: They will not have traveled the world.

5) Will it have been a successful event?

Neg: It will not have been a successful event.

6) Will I have finished writing the report?

Neg: I will not have finished writing the report.

7) Will you have completed the assignment?

Neg: You will not have completed the assignment.

8) Will he have painted the entire room?

Neg: He will not have painted the entire room.

9) Will she have learned a new language?

Neg: She will not have learned a new language.

10) Will we have organized the party?

Neg: We will not have organized the party.
