Neg: They weren't talking on the phone.

2) The airplane is taking off.

Neg: The airplane is not taking off.

3) She is wearing a bracelet.

Neg: She is not wearing a bracelet.

4) I am reading a book.

Neg: I am not reading a book.

5) The cat is sleeping on the couch.

Neg: The cat is not sleeping on the couch.

6) The children were laughing at a joke.

Neg: The children were not laughing at a joke.

7) She will be going shopping this weekend.

Neg: She will not be going shopping this weekend.

8) John will be working on his presentation.

Neg: John will not be working on his presentation.

9) She is wearing a dress.

Neg: She is not wearing a dress.

10) The teacher was writing on the whiteboard.

Neg: The teacher was not writing on the whiteboard.
