

Exercise Key-Continuous Form of Tense

1) He is studying for his exams.

Neg: He is not studying for his exams.

Que: Is he studying for his exams?

2) John will be studying in the library.

Neg: John will not be studying in the library.

Que: Will John be studying in the library?

3) The cat will be chasing the mouse.

Neg: The cat will not be chasing the mouse.

Que: Will the cat be chasing the mouse?

4) He is studying medicine.

Neg: He is not studying medicine.

Que: Is he studying medicine?

5) It is getting dark outside.

Neg: It is not getting dark outside.

Que: Is it getting dark outside?
