

Exercise Key-Continous Form of Tense

1) Is he studying for his exams?

Pos: He is studying for his exams.

Neq: He is not studying for his exams.

2) Will John be studying in the library?

Pos: John will be studying in the library.

Neg: John will not be studying in the library.

3) Will the cat be chasing the mouse?

Pos: The cat will be chasing the mouse.

Neg: The cat will not be chasing the mouse.

4) Is he studying medicine?

Pos: He is studying medicine.

Neg: He is not studying medicine.

5) Is it getting dark outside?

Pos: It is getting dark outside.

Neg: It is not getting dark outside.
