6) The construction workers had not been building the house for months before it was completed.

Pos: Had the construction workers been building the house for months before it was completed?

7) I had not been working on the project all day long.

Pos: Had I been working on the project all day long?

8) You had not been studying for hours before the exam.

Pos: Had you been studying for hours before the exam?

9) He had not been playing soccer since morning.

Pos: Had he been playing soccer since morning?

10) We had not been traveling for hours before reaching the destination.

Pos: Had we been traveling for hours before reaching the destination?
