



Perfect continuous Form of Tense **Write Negative Sentences (Key)**

1) Had the students been studying English grammar lately?

Neg: The students had not been studying English grammar lately.

2) Have we been waiting for our food for a long time?

Neg: We have not been waiting for our food for a long time.

3) Have you been watching TV all evening?

Neg: You have not been watching TV all evening.

4) Will the workers have been constructing the building for a year?

Neg: The workers will not have been constructing the building for a year.

5) Will the workers have been constructing the building for a year when it is finally completed?

Neg: The workers will not have been constructing the building for a year when it is finally completed.

6) Will I have been working on this project for three hours?

Neg: I will not have been working on this project for three hours.

7) Has he been playing football since this morning?

Neg: He has not been playing football since this morning.

8) Had I been studying for the exam for hours?

Neg: I had not been studying for the exam for hours.

9) Had you been studying for the exam all night?

Neg: You had not been studying for the exam all night.

10) Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain?

Neg: The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain.
