

Perfect continuous Form of Tense Write Interrogative Sentences (Key)

1) The students had not been studying English grammar lately.

Que: Had the students been studying English grammar lately?

2) We have not been waiting for our food for a long time.

Que: Have we been waiting for our food for a long time?

3) You have not been watching TV all evening.

Que: Have you been watching TV all evening?

4) The workers will not have been constructing the building for a year.

Que: Will the workers have been constructing the building for a year?

The workers will not have been constructing the building for a year when it is finally completed.

Que: Will the workers have been constructing the building for a year when it is finally completed?

6) I will not have been working on this project for three hours.

Que: Will I have been working on this project for three hours?

7) He has not been playing football since this morning.

Que: Has he been playing football since this morning?

8) I had not been studying for the exam for hours.

Que: Had I been studying for the exam for hours?

9) You had not been studying for the exam all night.

Que: Had you been studying for the exam all night?

The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain.

Que: Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain?
