Neg: She will not have traveled to Europe.

4) Will we have saved enough money?

Pos: We will have saved enough money.

Neg: We will not have saved enough money.

5) Will they have finished the construction?

Pos: They will have finished the construction.

Neg: They will not have finished the construction.
