2) He will have learned to play the guitar.

Neg: He will not have learned to play the guitar.

Que: Will he have learned to play the guitar?

3) She will have traveled to Europe.

Neg: She will not have traveled to Europe.

Que: Will she have traveled to Europe?

4) We will have saved enough money.

Neg: We will not have saved enough money.

Que: Will we have saved enough money?

5) They will have finished the construction.

Neg: They will not have finished the construction.

Que: Will they have finished the construction?
