

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) John has not been studying Spanish for a month.

Pos: John has been studying Spanish for a month.

Que: Has John been studying Spanish for a month?

2) He had not been studying Spanish for months.

Pos: He had been studying Spanish for months.

Que: Had he been studying Spanish for months?

3) She had not been teaching at the school for ten years before she retired.

Pos: She had been teaching at the school for ten years before she retired.

Que: Had she been teaching at the school for ten years before she retired?

The construction workers had not been building the house for several months before it was completed.

Pos: The construction workers had been building the house for several months before it was completed.

Que: Had the construction workers been building the house for several months before it was completed?

5) Sarah had not been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

Pos: Sarah had been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

Que: Had Sarah been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance?
