- 1) I enjoy playing video games.
- Neg: I don't enjoy playing video games.
- Que: Do you enjoy playing video games?
- 2) She has been gardening for hours.
- **Neg:** She has not been gardening for hours.
- Que: Has she been gardening for hours?
- 3) The car is parked.
- Neg: The car is not parked.
- Que: Is the car parked?
- 4) You have been working on the project all day.
- Neg: You have not been working on the project all day.
- Que: Have you been working on the project all day?
- 5) The students have been studying for exams.
- **Neg:** The students have not been studying for exams.
- Que: Have the students been studying for exams?
