Neg: She has not been gardening for hours.

Que: Has she been gardening for hours?

3) The car is parked.

Neg: The car is not parked.

Que: Is the car parked?

4) You have been working on the project all day.

Neg: You have not been working on the project all day.

Que: Have you been working on the project all day?

5) The students have been studying for exams.

Neg: The students have not been studying for exams.

Que: Have the students been studying for exams?
