Pos: Had it been raining heavily all day long?

2) John had not been studying for the exam all night.

The construction workers had not been building the house for weeks before it was finished.

6) You had not been studying all night before the exam.

Pos: Had you been studying all night before the exam?

7) He had not been working on the project since morning.

Pos: Had he been working on the project since morning?

8) She had not been practicing the piano for hours.

Pos: Had she been practicing the piano for hours?

9) We had not been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Pos: Had we been traveling for days before reaching our destination?

They had not been playing basketball for two hours before the game was canceled.

Pos: Had they been playing basketball for two hours before the game was canceled?
