

Exercise -Future Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

1) Sarah had not been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

Pos: Sarah had been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

Que: Had Sarah been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance?

2) The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

Pos: The children had been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

Que: Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining?

3) I had not been waiting for the bus since morning.

Pos: I had been waiting for the bus since morning.

Que: Had I been waiting for the bus since morning?

4) You had not been working on the project for hours.

Pos: You had been working on the project for hours.

Que: Had you been working on the project for hours?

5) He had not been studying for the exam all night.

Pos: He had been studying for the exam all night.

Que: Had he been studying for the exam all night?
