**1)** Will Sarah have been working on her novel for months?

**Pos:** Sarah will have been working on her novel for months.

---

**Neg:** Sarah will not have been working on her novel for months.

---

**2)** Had it been raining heavily all afternoon?

**Pos:** It had been raining heavily all afternoon.

---

**Neg:** It had not been raining heavily all afternoon.

---

**3)** Have we been waiting for our food for a long time?

**Pos:** We have been waiting for our food for a long time.

---

**Neg:** We have not been waiting for our food for a long time.

---

**4)** Had the company been developing new products for months before launching them in the market?

**Pos:** The company had been developing new products for months before launching them in the market.

---

**Neg:** The company had not been developing new products for months before launching them in the market.

---

**5)** Had she been practicing the piano for hours?

**Pos:** She had been practicing the piano for hours.

---

**Neg:** She had not been practicing the piano for hours.
