Pos: Sarah will have been working on her novel for months.

Que: Will Sarah have been working on her novel for months?

2) It had not been raining heavily all afternoon.

Pos: It had been raining heavily all afternoon.

Que: Had it been raining heavily all afternoon?

3) We have not been waiting for our food for a long time.

Pos: We have been waiting for our food for a long time.

Que: Have we been waiting for our food for a long time?

4) The company had not been developing new products for months before launching them in the market.

Pos: The company had been developing new products for months before launching them in the market.

Que: Had the company been developing new products for months before launching them in the market?

5) She had not been practicing the piano for hours.

Pos: She had been practicing the piano for hours.

Que: Had she been practicing the piano for hours?
