Neg: You will not have learned to play the piano.

2) Will he have repaired the car?

Neg: He will not have repaired the car.

3) Will she have achieved her ambitions?

Neg: She will not have achieved her ambitions.

4) Will we have completed the project on time?

Neg: We will not have completed the project on time.

5) Will they have reached a compromise?

Neg: They will not have reached a compromise.

6) Will it have been a memorable experience?

Neg: It will not have been a memorable experience.

7) Will I have lived in this city for five years?

Neg: I will not have lived in this city for five years.

8) Will you have saved enough money for vacation?

Neg: You will not have saved enough money for vacation.

9) Will he have received the award?

Neg: He will not have received the award.

10) Will she have written a best-selling book?

Neg: She will not have written a best-selling book.
