Write Interrogative Sentences (Key)

- 1)** John had not been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.
Pos: *Had John been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country?*

- 2)** Sarah had not been working out at the gym for an hour.
Pos: *Had Sarah been working out at the gym for an hour?*

- 3)** I had not been studying English for three months.
Pos: *Had I been studying English for three months?*

- 4)** You had not been working on the project all day.
Pos: *Had you been working on the project all day?*

- 5)** He had not been playing the guitar for two hours.
Pos: *Had he been playing the guitar for two hours?*

- 6)** She had not been writing her novel since morning.
Pos: *Had she been writing her novel since morning?*

- 7)** We had not been waiting for the train for half an hour.
Pos: *Had we been waiting for the train for half an hour?*

- 8)** They had not been practicing their dance routine for weeks.
Pos: *Had they been practicing their dance routine for weeks?*

- 9)** It had not been raining heavily all afternoon.
Pos: *Had it been raining heavily all afternoon?*

- 10)** John had not been studying for the exam since morning.
Pos: *Had John been studying for the exam since morning?*
