



Perfect continuous Form of Tense **Write Negative Sentences (Key)**

1) Have we been traveling for weeks?

Neg: *We have not been traveling for weeks.*

2) Has Mary been learning to play the piano for years?

Neg: *Mary has not been learning to play the piano for years.*

3) Had he been studying Spanish for months?

Neg: *He had not been studying Spanish for months.*

4) Will we have been waiting in line for two hours?

Neg: *We will not have been waiting in line for two hours.*

5) Had it been raining since yesterday?

Neg: *It had not been raining since yesterday.*

6) Have you been working late every night this week?

Neg: *You have not been working late every night this week.*

7) Had she been practicing the piano for hours?

Neg: *She had not been practicing the piano for hours.*

8) Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining?

Neg: *The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.*

9) Had they been playing football for the entire afternoon?

Neg: *They had not been playing football for the entire afternoon.*

10) Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain?

Neg: *The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain.*
