2) We will not be having a meeting tomorrow.

Pos: *Will we be having a meeting tomorrow?*

3) They will not be going on a trip next month.

Pos: *Will they be going on a trip next month?*

4) It will not be snowing in the morning.

Pos: *Will it be snowing in the morning?*

5) John will not be practicing the piano.

Pos: *Will John be practicing the piano?*

6) Sarah will not be painting a picture.

Pos: *Will Sarah be painting a picture?*

7) The team will not be preparing for the competition.

Pos: *Will the team be preparing for the competition?*

8) I will not be working on a project.

Pos: *Will I be working on a project?*

9) I will not be traveling to Europe next month.

Pos: *Will I be traveling to Europe next month?*

10) You will not be studying for your exam tomorrow.

Pos: *Will you be studying for your exam tomorrow?*
