Pos: John had been practicing the guitar for months before his performance.

Que: Had John been practicing the guitar for months before his performance?

5) Sarah had not been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain.

Pos: Sarah had been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain.

Que: Had Sarah been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain?
