Write Negative Sentences (Key)

1) Was the teacher explaining a difficult concept?

Neg: The teacher was not explaining a difficult concept.

2) Was she wearing a blue dress?

Neg: She was not wearing a blue dress.

3) Was the phone vibrating?

Neg: The phone wasn't vibrating.

4) Are they talking on the phone?

Neg: They are not talking on the phone.

5) Will you be attending a concert tomorrow?

Neg: You will not be attending a concert tomorrow.

6) Will John be studying in the library?

Neg: John will not be studying in the library.

7) Was John writing an email?

Neg: John was not writing an email.

8) Is the train leaving soon?

Neg: The train is not leaving soon.

9) Will Sarah be attending a party?

Neg: Sarah will not be attending a party.

10) Will I be reading a book?

Neg: I will not be reading a book.
