

Exercise Key-Perfect Form of Tense

1) Had he eaten lunch before the meeting?

Pos: He had eaten lunch before the meeting.

Neg: He had not eaten lunch before the meeting.

2) Have we cooked dinner?

Pos: We have cooked dinner.

Neg: We have not cooked dinner.

3) Has he lived in New York?

Pos: He has lived in New York.

Neg: He has not lived in New York.

4) Will it have been a fruitful collaboration?

Pos: It will have been a fruitful collaboration.

Neg: It will not have been a fruitful collaboration.

5) Will you have achieved your targets?

Pos: You will have achieved your targets.

Neg: You will not have achieved your targets.
