1) He will not be working on a new project.

Pos: *Will he be working on a new project?*

2) She will not be attending a conference next week.

Pos: *Will she be attending a conference next week?*

3) We will not be celebrating our anniversary on Saturday.

Pos: *Will we be celebrating our anniversary on Saturday?*

4) They will not be watching a movie tonight.

Pos: *Will they be watching a movie tonight?*

5) John will not be playing soccer on Saturday.

Pos: *Will John be playing soccer on Saturday?*

6) Sarah will not be cooking dinner for the family.

Pos: *Will Sarah be cooking dinner for the family?*

7) The team will not be practicing for the upcoming match.

Pos: *Will the team be practicing for the upcoming match?*

8) I will not be taking a vacation next month.

Pos: *Will I be taking a vacation next month?*

9) You will not be attending a concert tomorrow.

Pos: *Will you be attending a concert tomorrow?*

10) She will not be going shopping this weekend.

Pos: *Will she be going shopping this weekend?*
