Que: Had the construction workers been building the house for months before it was completed?

2) I had not been working on the project all day long.

Pos: I had been working on the project all day long.

Que: Had I been working on the project all day long?

3) You had not been studying for hours before the exam.

Pos: You had been studying for hours before the exam.

Que: Had you been studying for hours before the exam?

4) He had not been playing soccer since morning.

Pos: He had been playing soccer since morning.

Que: Had he been playing soccer since morning?

5) We had not been traveling for hours before reaching the destination.

Pos: We had been traveling for hours before reaching the destination.

Que: Had we been traveling for hours before reaching the destination?
