1) I will not have been working on this project for three hours.

Pos: I will have been working on this project for three hours.

Que: Will I have been working on this project for three hours?

2) He has not been playing football since this morning.

Pos: He has been playing football since this morning.

Que: Has he been playing football since this morning?

3) I had not been studying for the exam for hours.

Pos: I had been studying for the exam for hours.

Que: Had I been studying for the exam for hours?

4) You had not been studying for the exam all night.

Pos: You had been studying for the exam all night.

Que: Had you been studying for the exam all night?

5) The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain.

Pos: The children had been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain.

Que: Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain?
