

## Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

- 1) Pos: I will have been working on this project for three hours.  
Neg: I will not have been working on this project for three hours.  
Que: Will I have been working on this project for three hours?

- 2) Pos: He has been playing football since this morning.  
Neg: He has not been playing football since this morning.  
Que: Has he been playing football since this morning?
- 

- 3) Pos: I had been studying for the exam for hours.  
Neg: I had not been studying for the exam for hours.  
Que: Had I been studying for the exam for hours?
- 

- 4) Pos: You had been studying for the exam all night.  
Neg: You had not been studying for the exam all night.  
Que: Had you been studying for the exam all night?
- 

- 5) Pos: The children had been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain.  
Neg: The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain.  
Que: Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain?
